MISSION STATEMENT

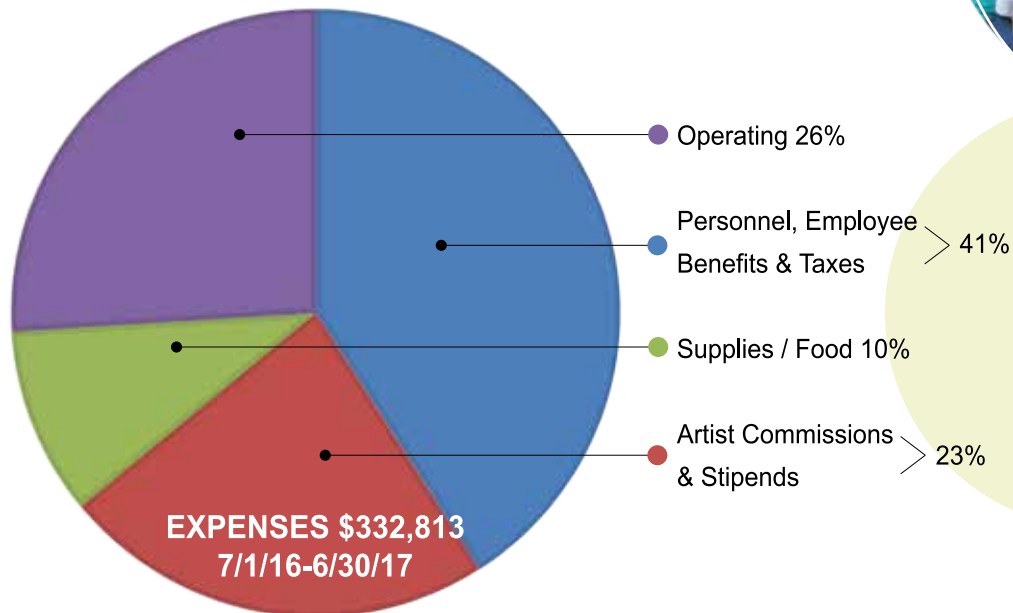
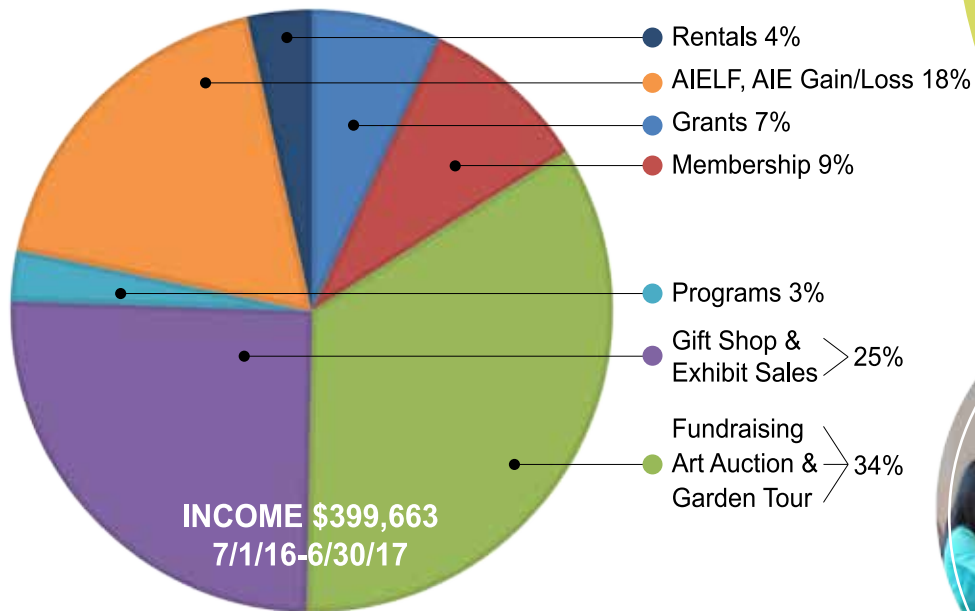
The Pence Gallery's mission is to serve the community through offering high caliber art exhibits, supporting the development of local artists, and providing educational programs for visitors of all ages.

ATTENDANCE & PROGRAMS OFFERED

The Pence served 16,269 people onsite and offsite, through gallery visits, outreach festivals, and events. In our youth programs, we served 649 students, parents & teachers, and facilitated a teacher training for sixteen teachers who teach 520 children. Through the Teens Take Charge program, twelve local teens participated in a four-month program to learn about art careers, and how to develop a community event for teen audiences that served 400 people. We facilitated education programs for 320 adults.

Through our ambitious exhibit program, we offered 257 artists an opportunity to exhibit in solo and group exhibits. This year, 471 people renewed their membership to the Pence.



GRANTS

The Pence Gallery had three grant projects that it facilitated over the year. For teen audiences, we coordinated the Teens Take Charge program, which connected local youth with professional artists. For young adults, we began Art After Dark, which invited 713 patrons into the Pence to experience interactive art & live music. For teachers and students, we completed a City of Davis arts contract that introduced the practice of hand building with clay into the classroom, along with a curriculum guide and hands-on tactile box.
