

Supply List for November Watercolor Portrait Painting Class

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Paper: The classroom practice will be painted on the Canson, XL Watercolor 9x12, 140 lbs, cold pressed. Walmart or Michaels sells them. You will be provided two sketched Canson watercolor paper sheets for two portrait paintings.* Also have a few extra sheets of the Canson watercolor papers. Please sketch the image of an eye, a nose and a mouth on your extra sheets of watercolor paper (I will email the reference pictures we will be using) so you are ready to paint them on the morning of the first day.

Brushes: Make sure you have a brush (#10 or #12) that comes to a nice point. I am using the Loew Cornell 9020 ultra round brushes. I was told they are no longer available at most retail stores but the Kingart Gold 9020 series brushes are the same as Loew Cornell.
