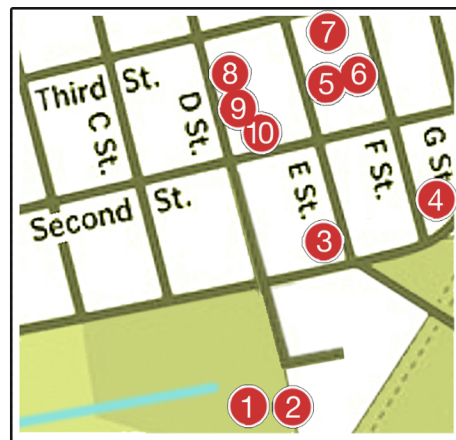

Visit the working artist collective and get your portrait done by Atelier Daniela. 10-minute charcoal and pencil drawings and 20-minute full-color pastel drawings available.



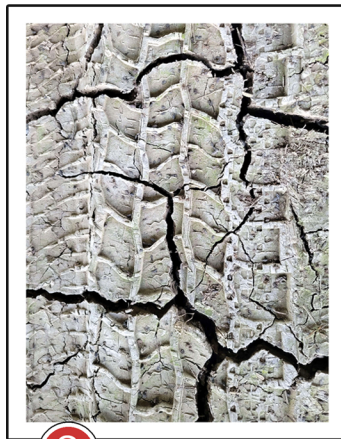

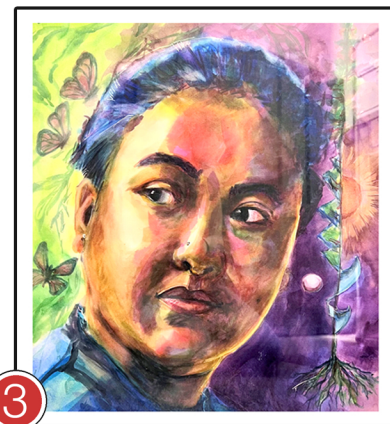
2. Third Space Art Collective

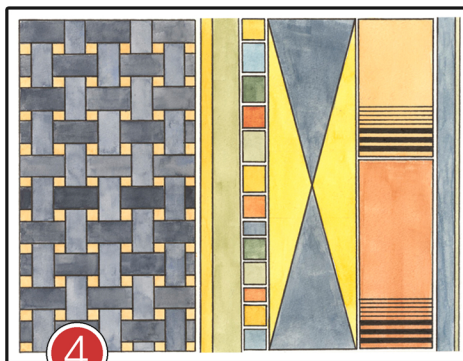

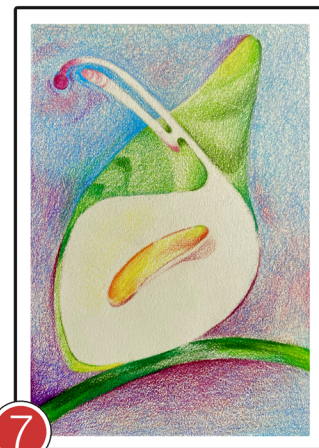
