



Salty Bird Glass Safety & Liability Waiver Form Stained Glass Workshop

All stained-glass workshop participants are required to complete and sign a liability waiver prior to participating in any lesson, and read and agree to abide by the safety procedures as outlined by Tiara Nixon/Salty Bird Glass. Participants must be a minimum age of 14 years old.

Stained glass involves the use of 60/40 leaded solder. Lead is generally considered safe unless ingested. For this reason, it's important to wash your hands after handling lead solder (including finished stained glass pieces). It also involves using chemicals (flux) and solder heated to 800 degrees. This process can create fumes. We use N95 masks and fume extractors during class to minimize exposure to fumes. Risk is considered low, but if you are sensitive to fumes you can bring a respirator mask to further protect yourself.

Safety and Limitations for Stained Glass Workshops

1. Always use appropriate containers and protective wear such as gloves, masks, and safety glasses when cutting and grinding glass, soldering, using chemicals and any other equipment.
2. Keep hair tied back.
3. Do not wear really loose fitting clothing or jewelry to prevent injury and damage.
4. It's ideal to wear pants and close toed shoes to class. **REQUIRED** when cutting/grinding.
5. Do not use any equipment without an instructor present.
6. Food is not permitted during class and drinks should be kept away from the work area.
7. Stained glass classes are not appropriate for pregnant women.
8. Always wash hands after soldering or coming into contact with solder and chemicals.

Release of Liability
