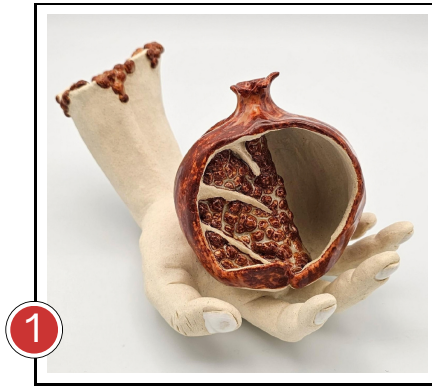

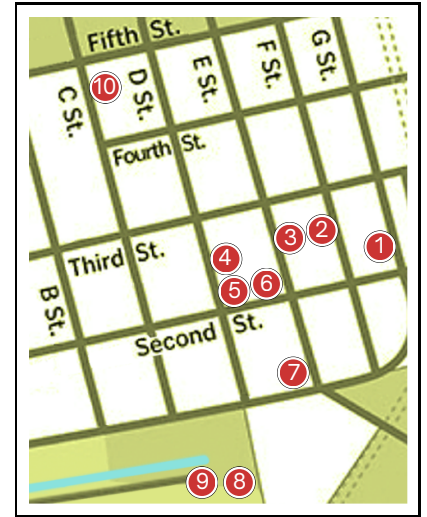

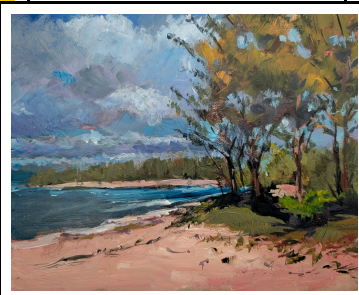
3. Davis Craft & Vintage Fair E St Plaza | 5-9 PM

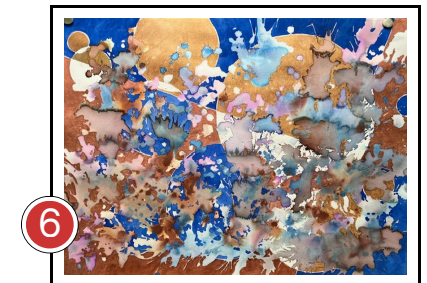

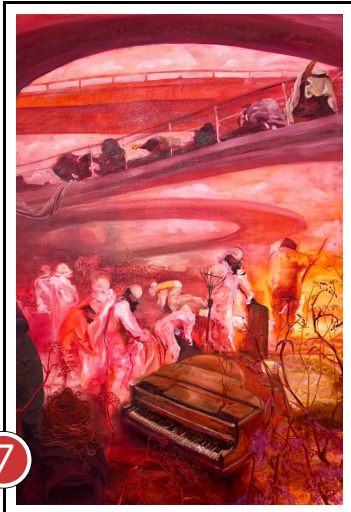
